

Physics 318 Homework Guidelines

- Online solutions are intended to be a help if you get stuck on a problem, You will maximize learning by working through as much of the problem on your own as you can. In general, therefore, your solutions should probably not look exactly like the posted solutions. Points, however, will not be taken off if your solution is like the posted solution. – Just be sure you really understand what you are doing.
- When a problem calls for a Maple solution, please submit your Maple worksheet to p318hw@byu.edu. Be sure to include your name and CID at the top of the file.
- For your written homework, please put your CID and the assignment number in the upper right hand of the page. Homework will be turned in to the Physics 318 slot of the distribution center across from N-375 ESC (under the windows).
- Homework may be turned in late, but it will be penalized 20% unless there are extenuating circumstances. You may turn in late homework up to one week after the due date. You may turn in some of your homework problems on time and some late. (One problem may NOT be turned in both on time and then late, however!) If you do did be sure to tell the grader that part of the assignment was turned in on time.
